- Most of the suggestions validate the actions taken from the first "sticky note" meeting almost 2 years ago. We, as a church, are on the right path and we want to continue and expand on it!
- Overwhelmingly, people want opportunities to come together in fellowship. We care about each other and our community.
 - Suggestions for fun fellowship events include: movie night, bowling, family game night, trivia night, hymn sing, drum circle.
 - Suggestions for community outreach include reaching out to the homeless and the LGBTQ community, and helping at a soup kitchen.
 - Several notes suggested expanded outreach to church members who are elderly or shut-ins.
 - People want opportunities to grow.
 - Bible study groups (Faith Building Team is planning this already)
 - Book groups
 - Arts and craft groups

Some notes had ideas that are easily achievable and have been forwarded to the appropriate group for action.

- Suggestion to post hymn numbers on the board has been sent to the Deacons.
- Several groups have requested a Church Spring Cleanup Day. The Building and Grounds Team is working on this.

Several notes suggested expanded coverage of outreach opportunities in the community, with the hope that members can join together and participate.

- Styrofoam recycling, Earth Day cleanup, Household goods drive, donation Yoga, Habitat
- A centralized calendar of events would be helpful
